

Magical Minds Studio COVID-19 and Social Distancing Procedures

What We Ask You Don't Send With Your Child:

- Toys, books and games from home
- Any writing or other items from home
- Gum

Procedures for dropoff and pickup:

- A masked employee will greet students each morning
- Parents/guardians pull up to the 2 front doors. Doors will be marked Group 1 and Group 2. Each family will be notified which group their camper will be attending in a separate email.
- Parents/guardians may help children out of the car, but you cannot enter the Studio. Staff will be at the door to escort the child inside and sign them in.
- Children must have their mask on before entering the Studio and will not be allowed without one. We have cotton masks available for \$5 if you do not have one.
- Staff will check each camper's temperature with a contactless thermometer before they enter the Studio. *If temperatures are high, campers will return to their parents/guardians.*
- Campers will be assigned cubbies with their names.
- Campers will be directed to wash their hands when they enter the Studio.
- Staff will guide students to their designated area and review procedures of distancing, masks use of supplies and activities.
- Campers will be required to wear face-covering when appropriate as defined by the CDC and will follow appropriate social distancing guidelines.
- Children will need to bring a water bottle labeled with their name with them each day.
- Campers must not bring items besides a water bottle and a snack/lunch from home.
- Campers will not be required to wear masks outdoors unless they are playing close to other people.

Procedures during camp activities:

- Students from the same household will be grouped together. All groups will have no more than 10 people.
- Campers will be assigned a washroom for their group.
- Marks on floors or tables will make spacing visibly clear to campers.
- Children will be required to wear a mask if they are not able to maintain 6-ft distance
- Key surfaces and areas (bathrooms, tables, places with food, entries/exits) will be cleaned frequently throughout the day.
- We will minimize the use of sharing materials and will divide basic materials up for each camper each day. All items will be sanitized and ready for the next day.

- We plan to leave our back door open to promote air circulation and have a couple fans running. If it does get too hot we will turn the air conditioner on and close our doors.

Procedures for exiting the Studio:

- Campers will wash hands prior to pick up, obtain their belongings, and wait with the teacher until a parent/guardian arrives
- Parents/guardians will pick up from the same door they dropped off.
- Staff will open the door to send campers out to the person picking them up.
